

The Anita City Council met in regular session on August 15, 2007 at 7:30p.m., at City Hall. Mayor Mike Krause presided and all council members were present: Bill Brenton, Jamie Stokley, Justin Larsen, Linda Firebaugh, and Marcia Hockenberry. Also present were Bette Dory, Gene Andrews, Jamey Herzberg, Jim Mailander, in addition to Scott Hoch with Electronic Engineering Co.

Motion by Hockenberry and seconded by Larsen to approve the agenda.

Scott Hoch with Electronic Engineering Co., provided options available regarding security cameras. Option 1 is a wireless system to be installed and to include a total of six cameras available to place anywhere throughout the City and costs \$28,000. Option two is a wireless system as well, however the cameras would run from the City Hall and costs \$23,100. Option three is an analog system with cable running from the City Hall with four cameras installed at that location and would include two cameras at the Community Center. Option three costs \$15,300.

Concerns regarding the area around the recycle bins being hard to access when it is muddy were discussed. Ideas included the possibility of pouring concrete under the bins or moving the bins to another location.

Concerns regarding the street on Hillcrest Drive were discussed. Larsen proposed contacting an engineer, possibly the company that worked with the housing development to get ideas for repair.

The liquor license for the Redwood was approved by motion by Stokley and seconded by Firebaugh.

Vote: Ayes, all. Motion carried.

Chief Holtz advised dog tags are being issued. In addition a dog kennel has been placed on the east side of the city shed for stray dogs. Also discussed by Holtz was city clean-up and issuing nuisance citations.

Mailander proposed a meeting be held for the Planning and Zoning board prior to next month's City Council meeting regarding the Deer Ridge division.

The Anita City Council met on Tuesday, August 21<sup>st</sup>, 2007 in a special informational session to take advantage of a presentation conducted by Electronic Engineering regarding the capabilities and installation of security cameras. Those in attendance: Mayor Mike Kraus, Council Members, Marcia Hockenberry, Linda Firebaugh, Jamie Stokley, Justin Larsen and Bill Brenton. Scott Hoch and Jerry Shindler were present as guests from Electronic Engineering and conducted the demonstration of the cameras.

The presentation included discussion of the wireless system versus the cable installation. Focal points of interest were the ability of three main components of the security system and included the frame rate (movement per second), resolution (clarity) and zoom capability. Each camera can be designed to perform specific functions based on the individual need at that particular location. In addition it may be possible to add DSL to the system.

Additional discussion will be held to determine the advisability of the project.
