

The Anita City Council met in regular session on October 8, 2008, at 7:30 p. m., at City Hall. Mayor Mitch Holmes presided and council members, Jamie Stokley, Marcia Hockenberry and Bill Brenton. Absent: Linda Firebaugh and Justin Larsen. Also present were Dave Winther, Corey Stephenson, Lynn Stephenson, Gene Andrews, Kim Wendt, Sherry Karns, and John McCurdy representing SWIPCO.

Mayor Holmes called the meeting to order. Motion by Hockenberry and seconded by Stokley to approve the consent agenda as presented. Ayes: all.

Motion by Brenton and seconded by Stokley authorizing a concrete surface to be poured on the city-owned property next to the Auto Splash Carwash. Nays: Hockenberry.

Motion by Hockenberry and seconded by Stokley to post “no-parking” signs on both sides of Rosehill Avenue from Fourth Street to the north. Mayor Holmes proclaimed no parking along either side of the street in this area. Ayes: All. The Council discussed posting signs along the south side of Main Street at the intersection of Chestnut Street, indicating parking of passenger car and motorcycles only. Additional discussion will be held.

Residents are reminded that burning of garbage and rubbish in city limits is prohibited by City Ordinance. Individual nuisance letters and or citations will be issued to residents violating the ordinance.

Discussion was held regarding relocating the City designated truck-parking. The Council proposed a temporary relocation at the lot immediately to the East of the current area. Additional discussion will be held to determine a permanent location. The current site needs to be cleared as soon as possible due to the beginning construction of a new business.

A letter of resignation of council member, Justin Larsen was read. Motion by Stokley and seconded by Brenton electing to fill the vacancy by appointment. Ayes: All.

Resolution 08-14 was approved on motion by Hockenberry and seconded by Stokley to adopt the “Designated Physician Policy Statement” as presented. Ayes: All.

Resolution 08-15 was approved on motion by Stokley and seconded by Brenton to adopt the “Emergency Incident/Training Rehabilitation Program for Anita Volunteer Fire Department as presented. Ayes: All.

Discussion was held regarding a “Return to Work Program” in conjunction with a work-related injury. Additional discussion will be held.

Motion by Hockenberry and seconded by Stokley designating Trick or Treat for Thursday, October 30, from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. This will coincide with the Chamber of Commerce party.
