

The Anita City Council met in regular session on November 12, 2008, at 7:30 p. m., at City Hall. Mayor Mitch Holmes presided and council members, Jamie Stokley, Bill Brenton and Linda Firebaugh. Absent: Marcia Hockenberry. Also present were Gene Andrews, Larry Phillips, Mary Lou Phillips, Mark Marnin, Sherry Karns, Jake Karns, Tom Harris and Ardith Harris. Mayor Holmes called the meeting to order. Motion by Stokley and seconded by Firebaugh to approve the consent agenda as presented. Ayes: all.

Mayor Holmes invited comments from those present who were interested in filling the vacancy of the council seat. The Council appointed Sherri Karns to fill the vacancy.

Discussion was held regarding properties that are in violation of the City Code of Ordinance. Certified letters will be sent warning the property owner to abate the nuisance as addressed. Failure to abate the nuisance will result in penalties as outlined in the warning letter or the City taking such steps as necessary to abate the nuisance with the cost being assessed to the property owner.

It will be a priority to get the area currently occupied as the truck parking cleared out as rock will be brought in anytime to begin the construction of the lumberyard. Temporary parking will be to the east of the current location.

Discussion regarding the City Financial Report was tabled. A special meeting will be held November 19, 2008 at 6:30 p.m. for the Council to review the report.
