

The Anita City Council met in special session on November 19, 2008, at 6:30 p. m., at City Hall. Mayor Mitch Holmes presided and council members, Jamie Stokley, Bill Brenton, Marcia Hockenberry, Sheri Karns and Linda Firebaugh. Also present were Gene Andrews, Larry Phillips, Mary Lou Phillips and Mark Marnin. Mayor Holmes called the meeting to order.

Sheri Karns took the oath of office and was sworn in by Mayor Holmes.

Questions and comments regarding the City's Annual Financial Report for fiscal year July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008 were addressed. Resolution 08-16 to approve the Annual Financial Report as presented was approved on motion by Hockenberry and seconded by Stokley. Ayes: All.

A petition was received by City Hall requesting a special election be held to fill the council seat vacancy. Motion by Hockenberry and seconded by Firebaugh to call for a special election on January 6, 2009 to permanently fill the remainder of Justin Larsen's council term. Individuals requesting to be on the ballot need to submit nomination papers to City Hall by noon on December 12, 2008

The dues for Pride membership were discussed. Decision regarding renewal of membership was tabled until the next regular council meeting.
