The Regular City Council Meeting of the Anita City Council was held September 14, 2022 with Mayor Knutson presiding.

Council Members present were: Deanna Andrews, Simon Jensen, Meghan Dorsey and Kevin Littleton and Mark Harris.

Also present were Cheryl Sokol, Kaycee Anstey, Craig Wahlert and Eric Steffensen with the Street Department.

Mayor Knutson called the regular city council meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

Motion by Littleton; second by Andrews to approve the agenda as posted. All voted aye. Motion passed.

Motion by Littleton; second by Dorsey to approve the consent agenda. All voted aye. Motion passed.

Motion by Dorsey; second by Littleton to approve the request to block off parking on Main Street and Walnut Street for Fall Fest on September 25<sup>th</sup>, 2022. All voted aye. Motion passed.

Motion by Littleton, second by Andrews to approve Mayoral Proclamation Honoring International Overdose Awareness Day on August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022. All voted aye. Motion passed.

Motion by Littleton, second by Andrews to approve cement work at Dave Boldt Field. All voted aye. Motion passed.

Motion by Dorsey; second by Jensen to approve pay application #19 for Group A of the 2020 Wastewater Treatment Facility Improvements in the amount of \$39,771.93. All voted aye. Motion passed.

Public Works Supervisor, Eric Steffensen, provided a safety update, streets update and sewer update. Building permits were also discussed at the following properties- 604 Maple St and 803 Walnut St.

Attorney Justin Hockenberry was absent.

Discussion held on nuisance abatements.

Public Input was received on the nuisance properties around town.
