Anita Municipal Utilities is a not-for-profit distribution utility. Wholesale power is provided from Western Area Power Administration (WAPA) and Resale Power Group of Iowa (RPGI). WAPA produces power with a series of hydro-electric generating stations along the Missouri River. RPGI purchases blocks of wholesale power that is then distributed to its members. Each month Anita Municipal Utilities purchases renewable energy credits that are sourced from Iowa wind generation and are green-e certified to promote renewable energy in Iowa.

Over 60% of Anita is supplied with underground electrical services, protecting the customers from outages caused by weather and vehicle accidents. In the event that an incoming line does fail, a series of three (3) generators are maintained to provide electricity in emergencies and programmed to run after a 3 second delay in power.

Anita receives its water from four (4) deep water wells in the Dakota Sandstone Aquifer. A \$1.6 million-dollar water treatment plant is scheduled to be completed in December 2017. The plant will be capable of treating 270 gallons per minute, which is 4 times more water than is currently being used.
