The Regular City Council Meeting of the Anita City Council was held August 10th, 2022 with Mayor Knutson presiding.

Council Members present were: Deanna Andrews, Mark Harris, Meghan Dorsey and Kevin Littleton. Absent was Simon Jensen.

Also present were Sara Sisler, Tracy Wilson, Jill Jessen, Eric Steffensen with the Street Department, and City Attorney Justin Hockenberry.

Mayor Knutson called the regular city council meeting to order at 6:33 pm.

Motion by Dorsey; second by Littleton to approve the agenda as posted. All voted aye. Motion passed.

Motion by Harris; second by Dorsey to approve the consent agenda. All voted aye. Motion passed.

Public Input was received on the Anita Bandshell Park Shelter Future Improvements.

Discussion was held on the Anita Bandshell Park Future Improvements including Grant Opportunities.

Motion by Harris, second by Dorsey to approve a shelter on city property located at Bandshell Park. Harris-aye, Dorsey-aye, Andrews-aye, Littleton-abstain, Jensen-absent. Motion carried.

Motion by Harris, second by Dorsey to apply for the Community Foundation Fall Grant Opportunity. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Harris; second by Dorsey to approve change order #2 for Group A of the 2020 Wastewater Treatment Facility Improvements for the net decrease of \$4,990.81. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Dorsey; second by Andrews to approve pay application #18 for Group A of the 2020 Wastewater Treatment Facility Improvements in the amount of \$23,061.69. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Dorsey; second by Andrews to approve Resolution 2022-42 "PROVIDING PRELIMINARY APPROVAL OF AN APPLICATION FOR TAX ABATEMENT." Roll call vote: Harris-aye, Andrews-aye, Littleton-aye, Dorsey-aye, Jensen-absent. Resolution passed.

Motion by Dorsey; second by Andrews to approve application for tax abatement for Amber Beerman (Amber McClain) at 408 Main. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Dorsey; second by Andrews to approve Resolution 2022-43 “ESTABLISH THE MILEAGE REIMBURSEMENT RATE FOR CITY OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES AS OF JULY 1, 2022.” Roll call vote: Harris-aye, Andrews-aye, Littleton-aye, Dorsey-aye, Jensen-absent. Resolution passed.

Public Works Supervisor, Eric Steffensen, provided a safety update and streets update. Building permit at 104 Linn Street was discussed.

City Attorney, Justin Hockenberry provided an update to the council.

Discussion held on nuisance abatements.
