RESOLUTION NO. 21-12

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MAXIMUM PROPERTY TAX DOLLARS FROM CERTAIN LEVIES FOR THE CITY'S PROPOSED BUDGET YEAR JULY 1, 2021 TO JUNE 30, 2022.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Anita have considered the proposed FY21-22 city maximum property tax dollars for the affected levy total, and

WHEREAS, a notice concerning the proposed city maximum property tax dollars was published as required and posted on city web site and/or social media accounts if applicable,

WHEREAS, a public hearing concerning the proposed city maximum property tax dollars was held on February 10, 2021,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Anita, that the maximum property tax dollars for the affected tax levies for FY21-22 shall not exceed the following total:

Total maximum levy for affected property tax levies of \$362,641.


The Maximum Property Tax dollars requested in the total maximum levy for affected property tax levies for FY2021-2022 represents an increase of greater than 102% from the Maximum Property Tax dollars requested for FY2020-2021.


